To maintain supply of the high-quality chicken you expect from us, Chick-fil-A shifted from chicken raised without antibiotics to No Antibiotics Important To Human Medicine (NAIHM) in the Spring of 2024.

What is NAIHM at Chick-fil-A?

NAIHM restricts the use of those antibiotics that are important to human medicine and used to treat people. Animal antibiotics are used to address sickness and protect overall animal health.

Does Chick-fil-A use hormones or antibiotics in your chicken?

Like all chicken produced in Canada and the United States all of our chicken is real breast meat with no fillers or added hormones or steroids.

We take great care in how we source our ingredients and partner with suppliers who share our values. And since we're all about chicken, you can be sure we're extremely selective about the chicken we serve.
